# What is the MMUF program? What are its overarching goals?

- \* The Andrew W. Mellon Foundation founded the program to diversify the professoriate
- \* Acceptance of an offer into the program represents a serious two-year commitment
- \* Designed to prepare you for a doctorate program and, eventually, a career as an academic
- \* Cornerstones of the program:
  - \* Independent research
  - \* Relationship with a faculty mentor
  - \* Demystification of and introduction to the academic culture

- \* American citizen
- \* GPA of 3.0 or above
- \* A strong interest in earning your PhD and becoming a professor in one of the Mellon approved fields
- \* A prospective faculty mentor
- \* A prospective research project
- \* A major in one of the Mellon fields of study



- \* We require an application form, a transcript, a personal statement, a writing sample, and two letters of recommendation.
- \* All materials are due in early February.
