Fellowship: Jane C. Waldbaum Archaeological Field School Scholarship **Description:** This scholarship is intended to help students who are planning to participate in archaeological field work for the first time. Students majoring in archaeology or related disciplines are especially encouraged to apply. The Scholarship Fund provides \$1000 each to help pay expenses associated with participation in an archaeological field work project (minimum stay one month/4 weeks).

Eligibility: The scholarship is open to students who have begun their junior year of undergraduate studies at the time of application and have not yet completed their first year of graduate school at a college or university in the United States or Canada. Fellowship: Jennifer C. Groot Memorial Fellowship

Description: Jennifer C. Groot Memorial Fellowships will be up to three awards for undergraduate or graduate students to enable their participation in an archaeological excavation or survey in Jordan. The fellowships are to assist in partial payment of essential expenses and are strictly limited to students with little or no prior archaeological field experience. \$1500 for each award

Description: The Bert and Sally de Vries Fellowship provides support in the amount of \$1,200 to an undergraduate or graduate student of any nationality except Jordanian citizens for participation on an archaeological project or research in Jordan. The fellowship must be used during the period between May 1, 2016 and April 30, 2017. The fellowship is to assist in partial payment of essential expenses. Students whose expenses are being borne largely by the project are ineligible. Applicants must be enrolled students at the time of application. This fellowship may be combined with other ACOR fellowships.
