May 2015

version 2.001 of AttikaU, BosporosU, KadmosU

-- added 02BB for mirroring of 02BC; added 037F capital Yot; overstroke precomposed Greek: added 28 glyphs for 24 main lowercase letters and lowercase koppa and stigma and final sigma and lunate sigma

--changed substitution instructions from being liga table to being ccmp table, so that most combinations work automatically in most applications

--fixed some open contours in AttikaU Bold

--adjusted theta in KadmosU to match the normal height of other tall characters

--corrected code points to corner brackets to 2E22-25

January 2012

version 1.400 of AttikaU, BosporosU, KadmosU

--created styled versions of all three fonts (italic, bold, bold italic)

--updated regular version to 1.400: in most cases this involved no changes to the characters, only to the name and copyright information, but two incorrect characters in BosporosU (from the group of alternative forms of capital vowel with iota adscript/subscript) were corrected

May 2008

version 1.30 of AttikaU, BosporosU, KadmosU

--added glyphs for dotted Greek letters, with OpenType definitions to invoke precomposed dotted glyphs when a regular polytonic character (including those with accents) is followed by combining dot below U+0323

January 2008

version 1.20 of AttikaU, BosporosU, KadmosU

--produced versions without adding MIF for better performance in Word 2008, TextEdit, etc.

December 2007

version 1.10 of AttikaU, BosporosU, KadmosU

--added brackets to AttikaU and BosporosU

--added 035d-035f to all

--added to all PUA characters for epsilon macron with circumflex, circumflex smooth, and circumflex rough, and same three for omicron macron

--revised ligature tables (OpenType and MIF) to deal with those new chars and to allow for full decomposition of chars with macron and breve

April 2007

version 1.02 of KadmosU

--Added forthcoming new half square brackets (U+2E42-2E45). These characters are not yet referenced in the inputs.

--added 'languagesystem dflt dlft;' as first line of OpenType table in FontLab in order to allow Mac OS Leopard to pay attention to ligatures (they might be ignored for Greek if the script tag is latn, which it would be by default if this command were not included).

--changed [hhea] vertical setting from 750 to 800 in TT and 800 to 850 in PS version
