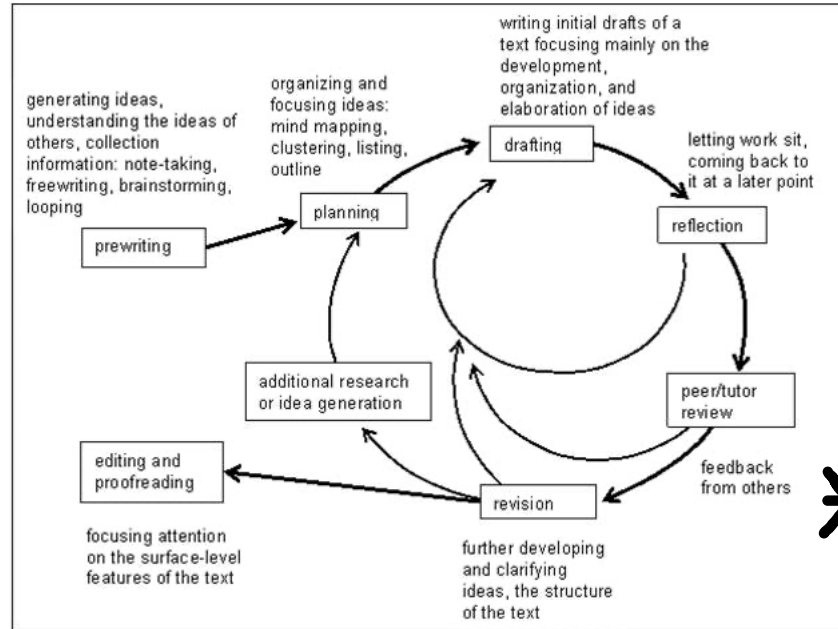

Seeking feedback during the writing process can help you not only with revision but also during prewriting, planning, or even drafting. This semester, you'll visit the Writing Center twice. You get to choose when in your writing process you want to go and for which assignments. So that you don't procrastinate, you're required to visit once before fall break and a second time before the end of classes.

Instructions:

- I suggest working on your ESEM essays! But you can choose a writing assignment from any course.
- Meet with any tutor. You don't need to meet with the same person both times.
- Participate actively in the conversation.
- Stay at least 45 minutes. If the conversation ends early, stay and write.
- Take notes during the conference.
- Ask the tutor to email you a copy of the conference report as confirmation of your visit. The conference report is a 1-paragraph summary of the conversation.
- Write a 2-3 paragraph reflection on the experience and upload the reflection and a copy of the conference report to Moodle.

Below are questions you may wish to consider before writing the reflection. Don't try to answer them all in your written response.

- How useful was the conference overall? Why?
- How comfortable did I feel sharing my writing with a peer?
- How much of the paper did I have written before I went? Would I prefer to visit during a different point in the writing process?
- What were my biggest take-aways from the conference?
- What did I realize about my draft? What do I plan to do next as a result?
- Did I learn any strategies or techniques that I might use again?
- What did I learn about writing?
- What did I learn about myself as a writer?
- What did I learn about the writing process?
